INSTRUCTIONS

1. Photocopy the brick wall and teddy bear template (p. 63); enlarge to the required size. Make five copies. Colour and glue the wall segments together on a large sheet of coloured card to make the background. Laminate.
2. Put a strip of self-adhesive 'loop' Velcro® across the top of the wall to hold the five teddies (see p. 21).
3. Decorate the teddies. Glue onto card and cut out. Laminate, unless you are using tactile materials. Put a piece of self-adhesive 'hook' Velcro® on the back of each teddy.
4. Photocopy the song symbol (p. 54); enlarge if needed. Glue onto card. Laminate, unless you are using tactile materials. Put a piece of 'hook' Velcro® on the back.

USING THE SONG BOARD

Start with the five teddies sitting on the wall.
Choose five students to each remove one teddy
from the song board as the song progresses.

You may wish to put the numerals 1 to 5 on the
teddies to practise numeral recognition.

Have the students put the teddies back on the
song board after the final verse. If the teddies
are numbered, your students can practise
sequencing the numerals 1 to 5.

When the teddies have been put back on the
wall, have the whole group count the teddies
from one to five.
